- The next highest bidder will have second choice, and so on until all VIPs are spoken for.
- Tables will be reserved for winning bidders and their chosen coach or player.
- Bids, which will remain confidential, must be postmarked or delivered by Monday, May 4.
- We suggest odd bids (such as \$117, \$189, etc.) to reduce the chances of ties. Ties will be broken by coin toss.
- Bids are for seating privileges only and do not include the price of the meal or membership.
